

# Featured Project: Gracechurch Street, London



## Stone Type: Limestone, Granite

This new infill office building in the centre of London is clad to the main front elevation with a grey granite base course and limestone to the façade.

The seven-storey building has various stonemasonry features, including two-storey high window mullions at the second floor and a heavy corbelled cornice course at the sixth floor. Internally, a blue grey limestone was used in the lift lobbies and main reception area.
