Highland Lodge, Rannoch Moor

Stone Type: Granite

Located in the Central Highlands of Scotland, this must be one of the most remote projects Stirling Stone has undertaken.

A striking contemporary design at the head of a loch, the external façade was built in a granite which would complement the older surrounding buildings. This particular stone was also chosen for its durability, an essential requirement to protect the building from typically harsh Scottish winters.

Stirling Stone undertook the complete design, supply and installation of the entire façade along with internal stone staircases, limestone bathrooms and large feature fireplaces in granite.
