



Featured Project: Isleburgh Complex, Lerwick

Stone Type: Sandstone

Lerwick's central public school was transformed into a high quality community centre. Stirling Stone carried out extensive restoration and alteration work, including the formation of a new main entrance arch in keeping with the existing façade.

This features stone plaques incorporating lettering, rosettes and a raven emblem. All of these had been badly eroded and replacement stones were hand-carved at our workshops. An extensive programme of indenting and replacement of masonry dressings plus complete repointing ensured the restoration of the building to its original grandeur.
