

Featured Project: Loch Lomond Golf Club, Scotland



Stone Type: Marble, Slate, Sandstone

As part of the development of this world famous golf club, the old Ross Dhu House was completely refurbished to form the new main club house. Stirling Stone and Toffolo Stirling carried out extensive external and internal stonemasonry works to the building.

Externally, the majority of the high level parapet was taken down and rebuilt, with stone replacement to the rest of the elevations. Also externally, large stone kerbs were laid to the gravel perimeter roadway and car park, while at one end of the house a patio area was created with radiating random stone paving. Internally, the main locker rooms had a variety of marbles used for the showers, vanity unit tops and splash backs. Limestone was also laid to the main corridor areas.
