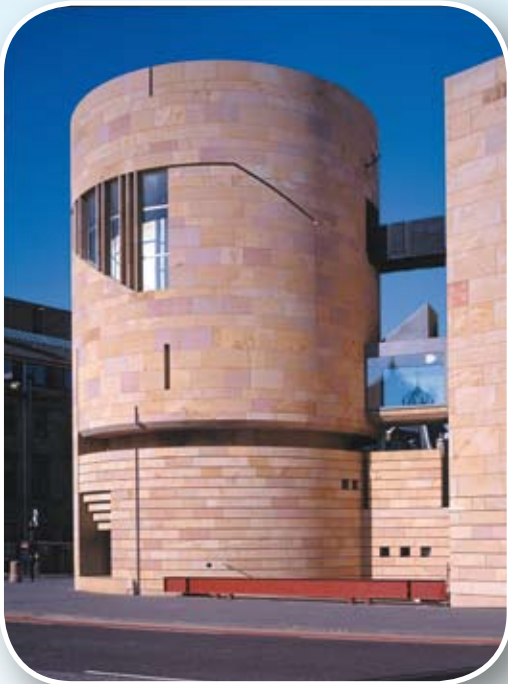
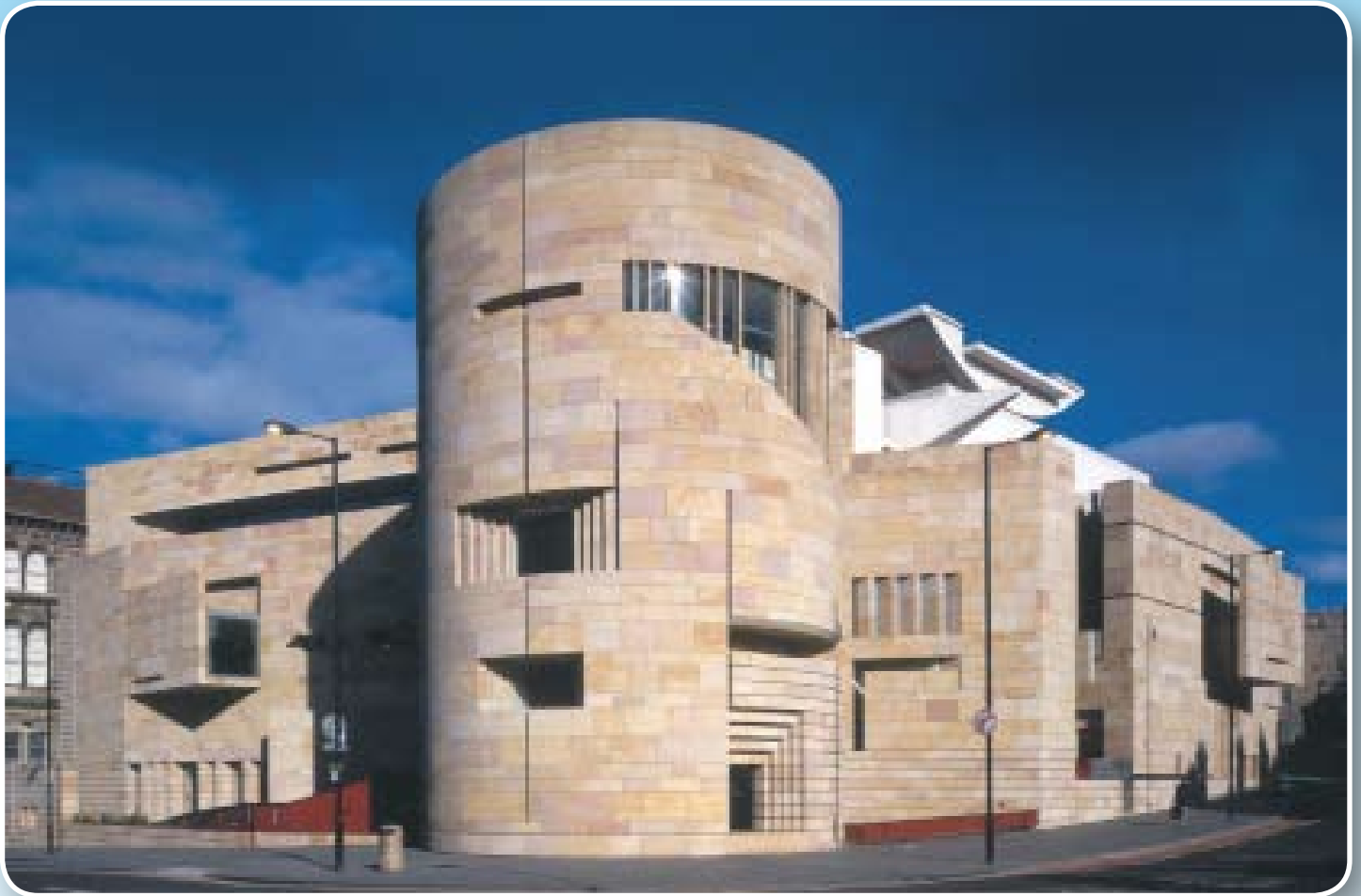


Featured Project:

National Museum of Scotland, Chambers Street, Edinburgh



Stone Type: Sandstone

This award-winning building is a unique design in sandstone rainscreen cladding with each elevation reflecting the surrounding townscape.

The open joint construction, with no mortar bedding, entailed supporting and fixing each stone individually using stainless steel corbels and restraints. Every stone had to be produced to especially fine tolerances to achieve the consistent joint width this type of cladding system demands.

Stirling Stone provided an all-inclusive service for this landmark project embracing stone testing, design and detailing of stonework and associated fixings, stone production and site installation.
